How to use the table

The functionalities of the Survey Results table are:

Search function

In the search box, type any keyword such as CoupeID, species name and survey technique.

The results will dynamically update once keywords are entered in the search box.

Sorting function

Each column has a sorting sign turned on. Once clicking the sorting sign on each column, the table will be automatically sorted ascending/ descending.

Display function

You can use the dropdown arrow to show the number of records (entries) display on the window or research results. If you scroll down to the end of the page, it will tell you the total number of results or on search results.

Download function

You can download the csv or excel of the survey results. If keywords have already entered, the downloaded csv or excel file only shows the records have been searched.
