

Public land event fees

The fees applying to events held on Forest Fire Management Victoria managed land are detailed below.

Which event fee schedule applies to my event?

There are three different event categories to which different fees apply. They are:

- Community events
- General events
- Commercial events

Event category	Definition	Examples	Event fee	Spectator fee
Community Events	An event where the Permittee is a not for profit group or charity, or the sole beneficiary of the event is a not for profit group or charity.	E.g. Event organised by a school	\$0	\$0
General Events	Non-commercial events that revolve around an organised event or recreational activity, often of a competitive nature, that are not community events and are not for profit.	E.g. Car rally, mountain bike race, orienteering event	\$0	\$0
Commercial event	Events run in whole or part for profit, with Event Directors receiving payment.	E.g. Music festival, duathlon/fun runs, trailbike/ mountain bike event with entry fees/prizes	\$1.10 per person/day	\$1.10 per spectator/day
