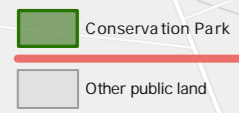


Hepburn Conservation Park



Key Features

The Hepburn Conservation Park (approximately 2,700 hectares) comprises part of the existing Wombat State Forest north-west of Hepburn Springs. The park is situated in the Country of the Dja Dja Wurrung People.

The park will protect high natural values including significant amounts of vegetation types under-represented in Victoria's parks and reserves. The threatened brush-tailed phascogale has been recorded here.

Most current recreational activities can continue in the new park other than recreational hunting and prospecting. Horse riding and dog walking will be permitted in designated areas.
